

important to first embrace any FEARS.



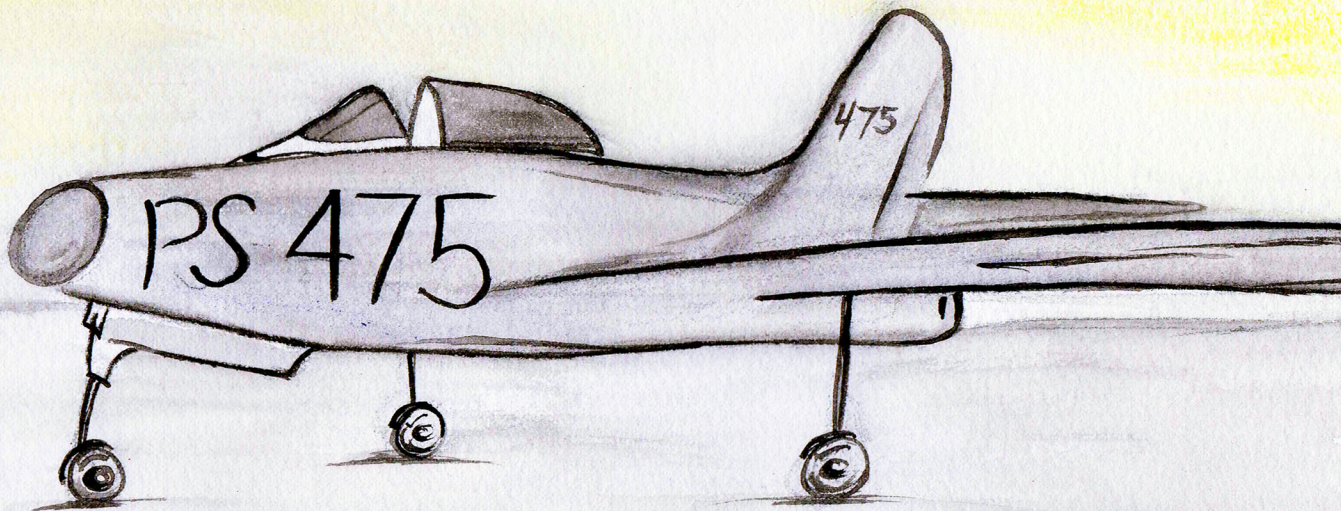




Dreams will push you to find friends
