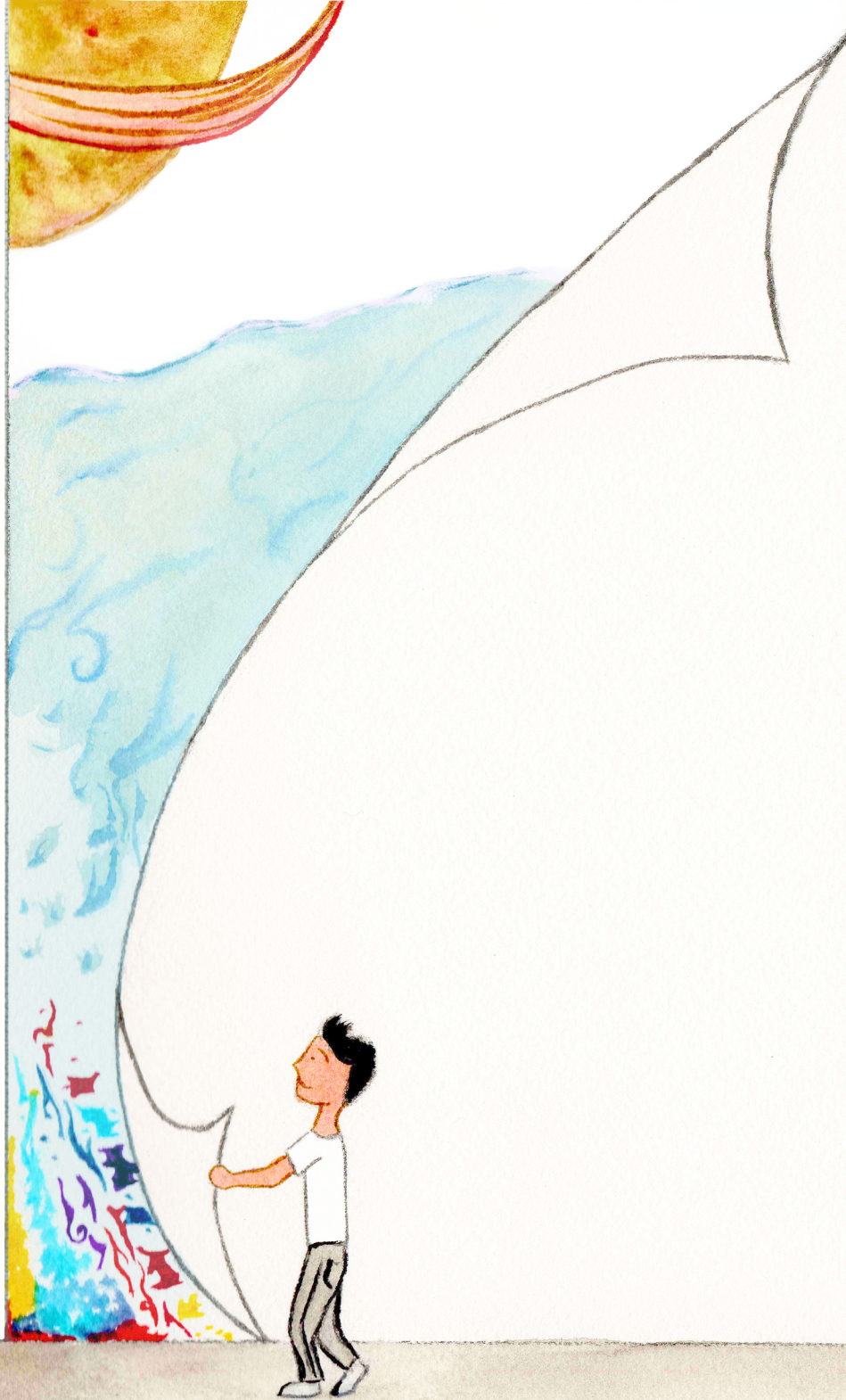
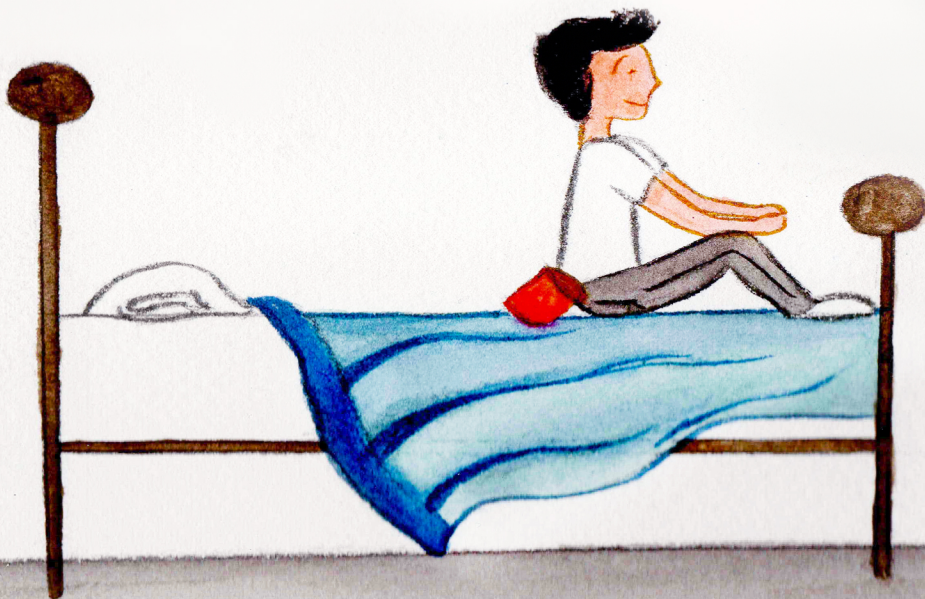

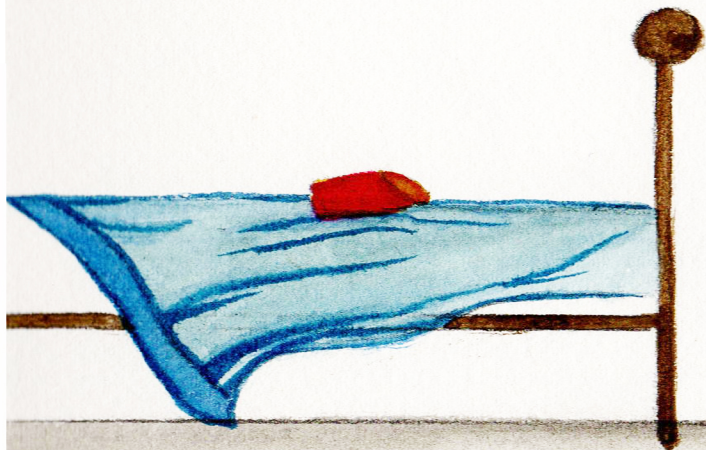


Sometimes I would just sit on my bed and

a single thing that surrounded me.

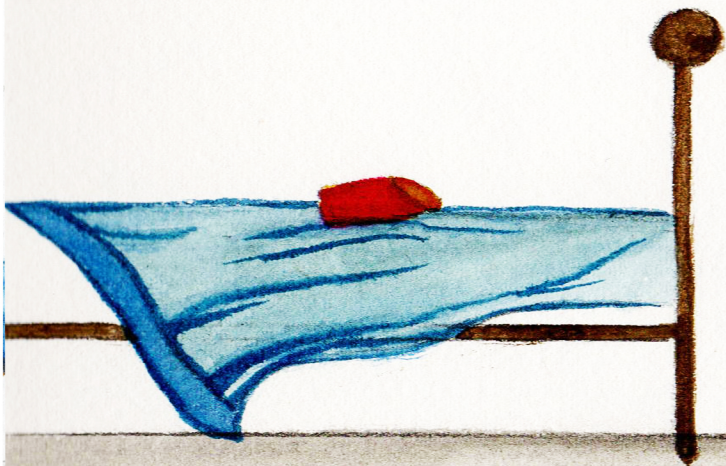
Every now and then, I would get an idea

so the walls just remained white.



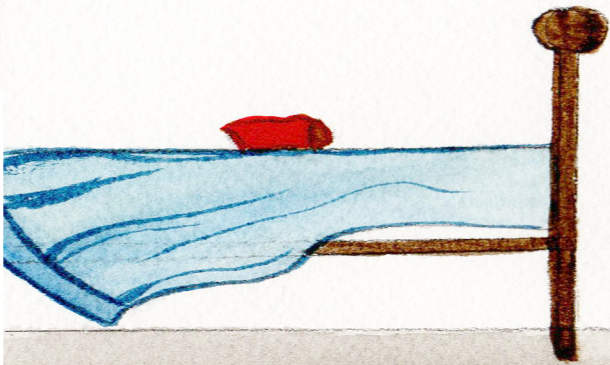
Then I noticed one edge of the wallpaper
had begun to peel...

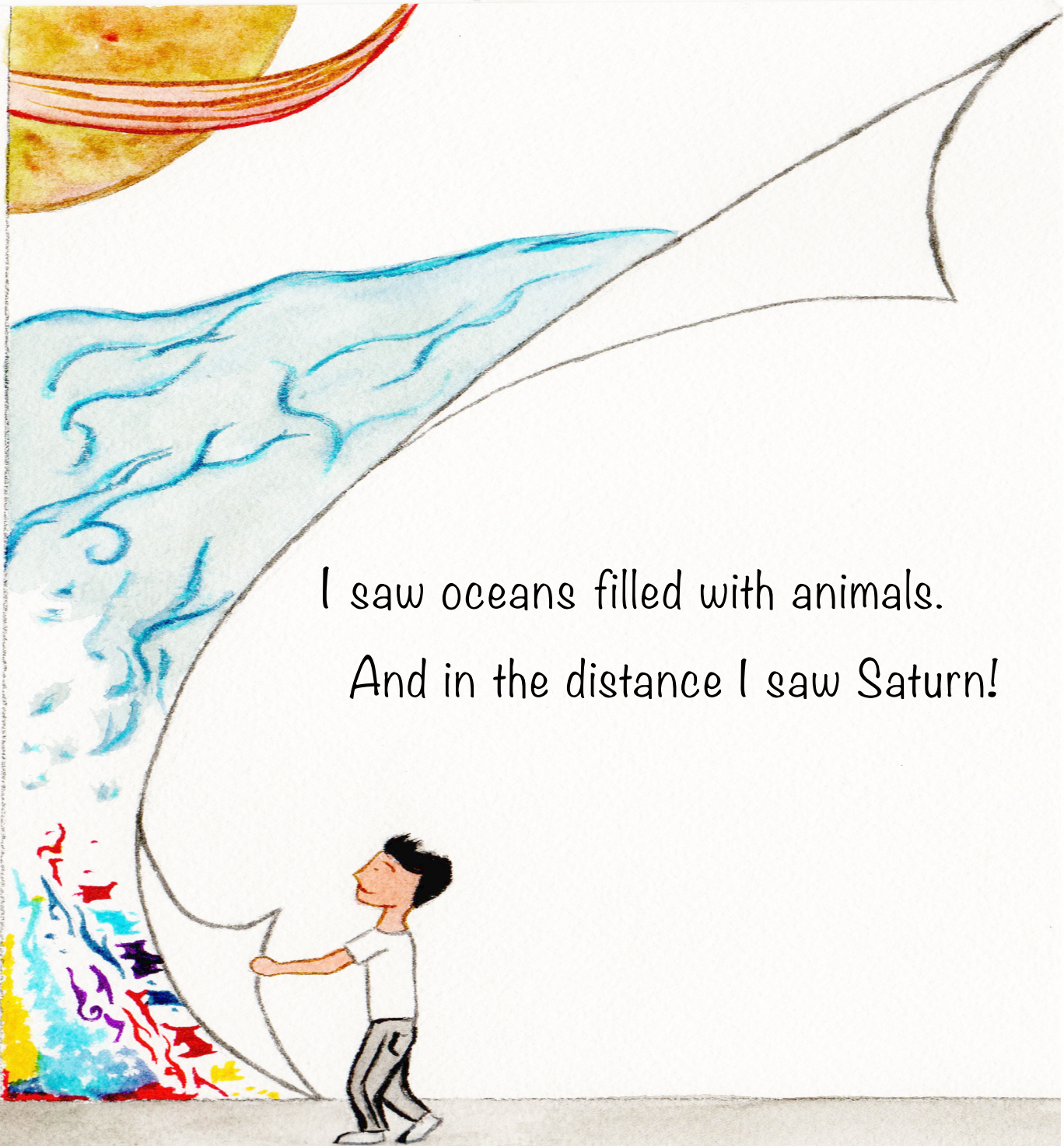




So I pulled it back to see
